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Complex Regional Pain Syndrome/Reflex Sympathetic Dystrophy

CRPS is a rare chronic neuroinflammatory disorder. There may be as many as 50,000 new cases of CRPS diagnosed each year. Most people with the disease typically see at least five physicians before being accurately diagnosed.

CRPS occurs when the nervous system and the immune system malfunction as they respond to tissue damage from trauma. The nerves misfire, sending constant pain signals to the brain.

CRPS generally follows a musculoskeletal injury, a nerve injury, surgery or immobilization.
